AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

The lower part of a body only, missing the pelvis and much of the right foot. The remains were completely skeletonized and disarticulated, with no soft tissues remaining.

As established from anthropology data, the person was adult i.e. over 17, and measured from 157 to 173 cms in height, but it was not possible to say whether male or female. There were no other identifying features.

Both femurs were fractured in their middle parts. There was nothing to suggest that either was a gunshot injury, and they may well have occurred after death from crushing or moving the body.

There were no other injuries or significant findings and so the cause of death in this person, from this examination, remains unascertained.

Unascertained
