AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

The bones from both halves of the pelvis plus the left thigh bone, a rib and one of the bones of the spine, all completely skeletonized.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male, aged between 17 and 71, and measured from 165 to 181 cms in height. There were no other identifying features however.

The right half of the pelvis was split in two, probably post mortem, from crushing or moving the body. The other bones were intact.

From this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person
