SUMMARY:

These were the virtually completely skeletonized remains of an adult male.

The autopsy revealed fractures of several ribs and of the seventh and eighth thoracic vertebrae, but it was not possible to determine if these injuries were sustained prior to death.

In the absence of any conclusive evidence of ante mortem injury it would be best to conclude that the cause of death was unascertained.


There was evidence of degenerative change to the lower part of the spine, but this was just an incidental finding.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 039B** was:

Unascertained
