AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

CASE NO: KK2 051BP General Body Parts

AUTOPSY DATE: 15.09.99
MORTUARY: Visoko

SUMMARY:

A large number of bones, from two or more individuals, from all parts of the body, and all completely skeletonized.

They appeared to be from adult people i.e. over 17.

One of the, at least, two skulls present, showed a probable gunshot exit hole in the upper part, but it was not possible to determine any entry site.

Elsewhere, there were fractures of several ribs, and of three of the arm and leg bones present. The former most likely occurred after death, the latter may or may not have been similar.

From this examination, the cause of death in these persons cannot be determined.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 051BP** was:
Unascertained
