SUMMARY:

A right foot, still in a shoe, the bones largely skeletonized but with a little dried tissue still attached to them.

From anthropology data, the remains were from an adult, i.e. over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female, or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries and no other significant findings. From this examination therefore, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 053BP** was:
Unascertained
