SUMMARY:

The bones of a left arm plus the right half of a pelvis, which may or may not have been from the same person.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male and aged between 17 and 57, but there were no other identifying features.

Both the upper arm bone and one of the bones of the forearm were fractured, though it was not possible to say whether these occurred before or after death. There were no other significant findings.

From this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
