SUMMARY:

An isolated skull minus the lower jaw, with no soft tissues attached.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male, and adult i.e. over 17, but it was not possible to be any more specific with regard to age. There were no other identifying features.

The only injuries present were fractures of the bones of the left side of the face, but these could well have occurred after death from crushing or moving the body.

There were no other significant findings, and so the cause of death in this person, from this examination, remains unascertained
