SUMMARY:

The body was totally skeletonized and almost complete. There was the fracture of the ^{lower} third of the left femur and the upper third of the left tibia.

From anthropological data the sex was determined as male, the estimated age between 12 and 17, and the stature as 176.4 +/- 7.7 cms.

The autopsy revealed gunshot wounds to the left shoulder with deep fractures of the vertebrae (T7 and T8) where the bullet pierced the spine, passing through the chest. The left knee bones were also fractured by a bullet that was found still in the "focus".

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 082B** was:
Firearm injury to the chest

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
