## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

### SUMMARY:

A right lower leg and foot, the latter still in a shoe. The remains were completely skeletonized.

From anthropology estimation the leg was from an adult person, i.e. over 17 but it was not possible to say whether male or female or be more precise as regards age. There were no other identifying features.

Both leg bones were fractured at their upper ends, but whether this occurred before or after death, is difficult to say.

There were no other injuries or findings, and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 122BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
