SUMMARY:

Portions of skull and of lower jaw, from at least two separate individuals. There were no soft tissues attached.

As much as could be established from anthropology examination, the remains were adult, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or determine anything further.

All the bones were fractured but whether this occurred before or after death cannot be established.

From this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in these persons.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 123BP** was:
Unascertained
