SUMMARY:

A left ankle and foot, with some dry tissues still adherent.

From anthropology examination, the bones were from an adult, but it was not possible to say whether male or female. The only further identifying feature was evidence of an old ankle injury, with healed fractures of two bones there.

There were no recent injuries, and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 124BP** was:
Unascertained
