A single small portion of skull from the top of the head, with no soft tissue attached.

From anthropology examination, it was not possible to determine anything particular from the bone fragments in term of age or whether male or female.

The skull from which the bone came was clearly fractured but it was not possible to say whether this occurred before or after death.

From this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
