## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## **SUMMARY:**

A collection of many bones from all parts of the body, from at least seven different individuals. Apart from a foot which was still in a shoe, there was no soft tissue remaining.

From anthropology examination the remains appeared to be mainly from adults, though there was one forearm bone from a young person i.e. someone under 17. At least three of the individuals were male; with the others it was not possible to say one way or the other.

Several of the bones were fractured. While most of these probably occurred after death from crushing or moving the body, or it was not possible to say whether they occurred before or after death, one portion of skull present showed a clear gunshot exit defect. This individual, at least, presumably therefore died from a gunshot wound to the head. For the other people, from this examination, the cause of death cannot be determined.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 001BP General Bag was:

- (1) Gunshot wound to head
- (2) Unascertained

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
