## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

### SUMMARY:

Parts of the bones of a left leg, still in trousers, completely skeletonized.

From anthropology examination they were from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Each of the three bones i.e. the thigh bone and both shin bones, were fractured roughly in their middle parts, with only the portions above and below the knee remaining. It was not possible to say whether the fractures occurred before or after death and so from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 008BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
