AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Parts of a skull including the upper and lower jaws, together with the bones of the upper part of the spine.

From anthropology estimation the remains were from a young person, someone aged between 14 and 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The skull was clearly extensively fractured, with much of it missing, but whether this occurred before or after death is difficult to say. There were no obvious gunshot defects in the portions remaining.

There were no other significant findings and so, from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 019BP** was:
Unascertained
