SUMMARY:

Two isolated bones – a right forearm bone and a portion of a left rib, neither with any soft tissue attached.

As far as could be determined from anthropology examination, they were both from an adult person but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The rib was fractured but this could well have occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and so, from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 020BP** was:
Unascertained
