## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

**CASE NO:** KK3 021BP

**AUTOPSY DATE:** 15.09.99

### SUMMARY:

A group of 8 vertebrae from the middle part of the spine, plus three left ribs and a number of rib fragments.

As established from anthropology examination, they were from an adult person, but it was not possible to say whether male or female. Several of the vertebrae were fused together, suggesting that he or she had some continuing or past inflammatory disease of the spine.

Several of the ribs were fractured but this could well have occurred after death, from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and so from this examination, the cause of death in this person must remain unascertained.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 021BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
