AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Bones from the chest i.e. ribs and vertebrae, together with the left upper arm, the remains being totally skeletonized, with no soft tissue remaining.

From anthropology examination, they were from an adult person, aged between 20 and 65, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Several of the ribs on both sides of the chest were fractured, but these would well have occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and, from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
