## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

### SUMMARY:

Two bones from a left leg – the femur and the tibia – completely skeletonized, with no soft tissues remaining.

As established from anthropology examination, the bones were from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The femur was fractured in its middle third, but as the upper part of the bone was missing, it was not possible to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and so, from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 039BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
