AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A skull minus the lower jaw but with the topmost bone of the neck also included. There were no soft tissues remaining.

From anthropology examination, the person was male and adult, but it was not possible to be any more precise as regards age or to determine anything further.

The front and right side of the skull were extensively fractured and several parts missing but this had the appearance of post mortem damage, caused by crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and so from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 050BP** was: **Unascertained**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
