SUMMARY:

Several bones from the chest including the ribs and some bones from the spine. There was no soft tissue remaining.

From anthropology estimation the person was adult i.e. over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Most of the ribs were fractured as was the left shoulder blade, but this probably occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 064BP** was:
Unascertained
