SUMMARY:

A single piece of bone only – the central part of a lower jaw.

From anthropology examination it was possible only to say it was from an adult person but not whether male or female.

The jaw was clearly fractured but as most of it was missing, it was not possible to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

From this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 066BP** was:
Unascertained
