SUMMARY:

Almost complete body, with saponified soft tissue still adherent to the trunk and limbs.

From the anthropological data the person was male, aged 31-71 and measured 166.2 +/- 7.7 cm.


He had been shot in the left upper part of the back as seen by comminuted fractures of the ribs and two bullets which were lodged in the soft tissues of the left lower chest. With such a gunshots injury it is highly likely that there would have been associated internal damage or complications.

There were bullets metal fragments in the mandible soft tissues and in the right third of the thigh.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 087B** was:
Bullet wounds to the trunk and right limb
