SUMMARY:

A complete skull minus the lower jaw. The brain was still present inside.

As established from anthropology examination, the person was male and adult, but it was not possible to be any more precise as regards age or to determine anything further.


Both sides of the face were fractured and pieces of bone missing but it is likely that this occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 092BP** was:
Unascertained
