## AUTOPSY REPORT

### SUMMARY:

A left pelvic bone plus the upper end of a femur.

From anthropology examination, the pelvis was from a man aged between 27 and 71, but it was not possible to determine anything further.

The femur was fractured, with only the head remaining. Whether this occurred before or after death however, is impossible to say.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 099BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
