## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

### SUMMARY:

A left arm including the hand, the bones completely skeletonized.

From anthropology examination, it was from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were fractures of three of the bones of the wrist and hand which would appear to have occurred in life, possible from a gunshot injury. The upper arm bone was also fractured but the upper part was missing and so it was difficult to say what caused it or when it occurred i.e. before or after death.

There were no other findings and, from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 102BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
