## AUTOPSY REPORT

### SUMMARY:

A left forearm bone and hand together with a few bones from the right hand.

From anthropology examination they were from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The forearm bone was fractured but much of it was missing and it was not possible to say what caused it or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 107BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
