SUMMARY:

This was the bodily decomposed and partially skeletonized body of an adult male.

The skull had been shattered and when reconstructed there appeared to be a bullet entrance hole in the back of the head with a further defect higher up in the skull. The appearances were consistent with the passage of a bullet through the head.

The pelvis and a number of the ribs had been fractured but there was no unequivocal evidence to indicate that these injuries had been sustained before death.

The remains of a ligature, used to bind the wrists were recovered.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 119B** was:
Gunshot wound of head

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
