SUMMARY:

A left lower leg and foot, with no soft tissue remaining.

From anthropology examination, the leg was from an adult i.e. someone aged over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

One of the leg bones – the fibula – was fractured in its middle third but most likely this occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 121BP** was:

Unascertained
