SUMMARY:

The bones of a left forearm and right hand with an additional single bone from a left hand. There was no soft tissue surviving.

From anthropology examination the bones were from an adult but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries, although there was a ligature around the forearm, made of a loop of nylon string.

From this examination it was not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 136BP** was:
Unascertained
