## SUMMARY:

Small part of a body only – skull including mandible, the upper spine (C1 - Th1) and some bones of a hand. There was some soft tissue adherent and the brain still inside the skull.

The remains were from a male adult, but is was not possible to interpret anything further in terms of age or build.

Although there were fractures of the left zygomatic arc and of both heads of the mandible their injuries probably were caused by post mortem influence. There were no other findings nor other injuries.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 147BP** was: **Unascertained.** 

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
