AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

The bones from a left arm, including some from the back of the hand. There were no soft tissues surviving.

From anthropology examination, the remains appeared to be from a young person i.e. someone under the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The upper arm bone was fractured in the middle but as the upper part was missing, it was difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 153BP** was:

Unascertained
