SUMMARY:

Fragmented pieces of a skull together with part of the lower jaw and the top bone of the spine.

From anthropology examination, the remains were from an adult person but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Both the skull and the lower jaw were fragmented but several pieces were missing and it was therefore difficult to say what caused the injury or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 163BP was:

Unascertained
