## SUMMARY:

A right foot, with the lower ends of the shin bones also included.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female.

The lower leg bones were clearly fractured above the ankle but most probably this occurred after death from moving the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
