SUMMARY:

A complete and intact skull including the lower jaw. There was some hair still adherent and the brain inside, but otherwise there was no soft tissue surviving.

As established from anthropology examination, the skull was from an adult man though it was not possible to determine anything further.

It was uninjured and from this examination, it was not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
