SUMMARY:

A left forearm and hand, with no soft tissues remaining.

From anthropology examination, it was from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There was a fracture of the lower end of the radius but the lower part of the bone was missing and so it was difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings, and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
