## **SUMMARY:**

These were the partially skeletonized remains, with saponified soft tissues still adherent to the bones. The body was almost complete.

From the anthropological data, the person was male, aged 31-71 years old and measured 163.2 +/- 7.7 cm in height.

He would appear to have died from a gunshot injury to the head, which had caused complete fragmentation of the base of the skull, very typical of a high velocity rifle injury, into the median occipital region there was the entry hole of the gunshot, oval shaped. The direction was tangential to the bone surface right to left.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 181BP** was:

Gunshot wound to the head
