SUMMARY:

The upper part of a skull together with the topmost bone in the spine.

From anthropology examination the bones were from a male adult, but it was not possible to determine anything further.

The skull was clearly fractured but this may well have occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body. Cereainly there were no specific features in the portion remaining, such as gunshot defects.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 466BP** was: **Unascertained**
