SUMMARY:

These were saponified and partially skeletonized remains, received partially disarticulated.

Anthropological data established that this person was a man, 31 to 71 years of age with a stature of almost 175 cm. No other significant identifying features were found.

Autopsy revealed a gunshot wound to the head which entered in the right base of the cranium, shearing off a portion of the right mandibular condyle, passing from front to back and toward the top of the head, passing through the region of the brain.

Also present was a gunshot wound of the right clavicle which might have been the primary site of entrance of the gunshot wound of the head.

Present as well were bilateral rib, left scapular, spinal, and bilateral pubic fractures indicative of post mortem crushing of the body.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 468B was:

Gunshot wound to the head
