AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

The upper half of a body including the skull and the left arm. The remains were largely skeletonized but with some dried tissue still attached in places.

As established from anthropology examination the person was male and adult, aged over 31 but there were no other identifying features.

There were fractures of the bones of the face and of the lower jaw, and also of several ribs on both sides of the chest, but these probably all occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 485BP** was:
Unascertained
