SUMMARY:

Bones from a left leg – the lower part of the femur, the shin bone and the kneecap, with no soft tissues remaining.

From anthropology examination they were from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The femur was fractured towards its lower end, but the upper part was missing and it was difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
