A right lower leg and foot, completely skeletonized.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female. He or she measured from 169 to 185 cms in height but there were no other identifying features.

There were no injuries and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
