#### SUMMARY:

A right foot still in a boot, with some greasy material still attached to the bones.

From anthropology examainton, the foot was from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Several bullet fragments were found in the foot and two bones were broken, indicative of a gunshot injury, though the relative lack of damage suggests that the bullet may have passed through another part of the body beforehand. It would not be expected to be a fatal injury.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
