SUMMARY:

A right foot with the lower ends of the shin bones still attached and a substantial amount of soft tissue still present.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17 but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The shin bones were both fractured at their lower ends with the upper parts missing, but most likely this occurred after death in moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
