## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

### **SUMMARY:**

A collection of pelvic and leg bones from at least two individuals.

From anthropology examination, one of the pelvic bones was from a young male, aged between 13 and 25, the leg bones also being from a young person, presumably the same one. The other pelvic bone was from an adult i.e. someone over 17, though it was not possible to say whether male or female.

There were no injuries and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in these persons.
