SUMMARY:

A group of bones from the neck region – the spine, right collarbone and the right top rib.

From anthropology examination they were from a young person, someone under the age of 21, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Both the collarbone and the rib were fractured, with substantial pieces missing, and while this could have been from a gunshot injury, this could not be proved, nor is it certain that the injuries occurred before death.

There were no other findings, and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
