#### SUMMARY:

These were the remains of an almost skeletonized body. The left limbs were partially missing as well as the lower half of the right arm. The skull was shattered.

From the anthropological data, the person was male, aged between 31 and 65 years, and measured 178.3 +/- 7.7 cm in height.

The autopsy revealed only the probable perimortal fracture of the left humerus and scapula, with a bullet fragment inside.

The case must remain unascertained.
