SUMMARY:

A small collection of assorted bones – a rib, a forearm bone and a foot with no soft tissues surviving.

As established from anthropology examination, the bones appeared to come from at least two individuals, one of them probably young i.e. under 23, the other an adult. From none of them however, was it possible to say whether they were male or female.

There were no injuries or other findings, and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in these persons.
