SUMMARY:

A left lower leg and foot, completely skletonized.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult over the age of 17 but it was not possible to say whether male or female. He or she measured from 163 to 179 cms in height.

The shin bone showed clear evidence of burning of one surface, this almost certainly occurring after death.

There were no other injuries or significant findings, and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
