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## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

### **SUMMARY:**

A right arm minus the hand but with the collarbone and shoulder blade also present. It was completely skeletonized, with no soft tissue surviving.

From anthropology examination the remains were from a young person, someone under the age of 21, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries or other significant findings, and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
